Solid Waste Disposal Facility Use Permit Application

Please Note:

- The County is not responsible for lost or undelivered mail. A new application and permit fee will be required if a claim of lack of delivery or receipt is made.
- A copy of your vehicle registration or proof of residency must be submitted with your application.
- Permits are valid from September 1 – August 31 and must be renewed annually.
- The permit fee \$100 for a full 12 months. Part-year fees are levied on a quarterly basis, per the schedule on the reverse of this form. A secondary permit is \$25, provided that both vehicles are registered to the same address. Permits will not be issued until payment is received.
- All patrons of Solid Waste Disposal Facilities must abide by the rules listed on the reverse of this form.

Solid Waste Disposal Facility Use Permit Fee Schedule

Fees are charged for a 12-month period beginning each September 1st. The permit fee is \$100 for the first quarter of the 12 month period. Part-year fees are levied on a quarterly basis, not to exceed the full year fee, per the following schedule:

Solid Waste Disposal Facility Rules

All Solid Waste Disposal Facilities owned or operated by Caroline County pursuant to Chapter 127 – Littering and Solid Waste Management of the Code shall be subject to the following rules:

- A. A valid Disposal Facility Use Permit is required to use any County owned or operated Solid Waste Disposal Facility.
- B. The Solid Waste Disposal Facilities are intended for residential solid waste only. Commercial solid waste is prohibited.
- C. Users are limited to one visit to each Solid Waste Disposal Facility per day.
- D. Acceptable material is limited to general household trash (maximum 10 bags) and the following recyclables: motor oil, anti-freeze, cardboard, and scrap metal.
- E. Unacceptable materials include, but are not limited to, tires, wood and lumber, rubble, demolition debris, construction debris, yard waste, furniture, carpet, and large appliances.
- F. Items not accepted at County owned or operated Solid Waste Disposal Facilities may be accepted at the Mid-Shore II Regional Landfill. Exceptions may exist for hazardous waste.
- G. Facilities are only to be accessed during posted operating hours.
- H. Users must comply with all instructions by County staff when utilizing the facilities.
- I. Users of Solid Waste Disposal Facilities may not verbally or physically threaten, harass, or abuse County staff working at the facilities. Doing so may result in the loss of the user's permit and a future prohibition against receiving a permit.

**USING THE COLLECTION SITES WITHOUT A VALID PERMIT OR

AND A FINE OF \$300 FOR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATIONS.**
